If your child is eligible for funding from January I will provide you with the forms soon but if you think that you are eligible for the 30 hour funding please register with HMRC on www.childcarechoices.gov.uk If you are eligible you will be issued with a code but if you do not register in time you will not be able to claim the extended hours until after Easter so it is important that you get ahead now.

This Half Term's Theme
