September 2015 Booking Forms

Many of you will have received the September 2015 booking forms that I handed out at the end of last half term; our current children and their siblings have priority on bookings as long as forms are returned by Friday 27th March. From 13th April I will be sending booking forms out to children on the waiting list. I will confirm sessions booked from 11th May, but please note that changes can only be made up to 22nd May. After this date, all sessions booked on the September booking form will be charged in full for the first half of the autumn term. If you haven't received a booking form and would like one please let me know; your child's current sessions are **not** automatically renewable from September and a booking form is therefore necessary for those sessions to be booked again.

Session Increases for April 2015

If you would like to increase your sessions after Easter, please complete the slip at the bottom of this newsletter and return to me as soon as possible. Please bear in mind that this year has been extremely busy and the morning sessions are currently full; there are spaces available in the afternoons but it is important that I know your preferences early so I can arrange staffing as the afternoons are also busier than in previous years. Children who are turning 3 before 31st March 2015 are entitled to 15 funded hours after Easter. I will be sending out the Parental Contracts from the Early Years Funding team as soon as they are available to me, but please come and see me if you have any questions or would like some help arranging the extra sessions.

Fees

Please pay your fees promptly; there is a two week payment period, after which a late payment charge of £20 will automatically be added. The last day for payment is **Friday 6**th **March**, unless prior arrangements have been made with me.
