Pre School:

What an exciting year ahead we have for our pre schoolers we are so excited to help them get ready for their next big adventure...School!!

At Little Hands we always remember that every child is unique and needs to progress through their own milestones of development.

Play in these earliest years is the foundation building blocks for all future learning and to encourage independent learners. To embed ideas and thinking, to solve problems and work things out!

Play is at the heart of everything we do, alongside this we scaffold adult led learning to give the children exposure to ideas and opportunities that they may not have had. We have a huge variety of changing resources following their interests and opening them up to other opportunities. For example we have writing resources, these are not just pens and paper they are scrabble pieces, phonic stones, alphabet stones, diaries, sticky notes, calendars, cards, envelopes anything that can promote an Interest when the child is ready.

We help and encourage our children to develop skills of self-regulation, empathy, respect. To form friendships and be able to resolve conflicts. To develop an intrinsic desire to learn. To become an active learner who is curious to discover, find out and over come challenges. A child who is physically ready for school, core strength, coordination and development of gross motor skills and pivotal joints. A child who is happy, excited and eager to find out, solve problems and is confident in their own abilities.

These skills and so many more are 'school readiness'.

Garden

Although this week the weather is glorious it will start to change as Autumn creeps back in, our Garden is open all year around and it is one of the children's favourite places to play! We have been lucky enough to been given 10 all in one waterproofs which will help enormously with keeping as much mud of the children as possible! However if you have them please send them in with the children (named) so we can encourage them to put them on.

If the weather is sunny then please remember to apply suncream in the morning and we will reapply as needed during the day.



Illness

Our policy for the dreaded sickness and diarrhoea bug is 48 hours away from Nursery. Please don't bring your child into nursery until they have had 48 hours since their last bout. I really appreciate your support in this as I know how difficult this can be especially as normally after 24 hours they are bouncing around looking fine!!
