Happy New Year. Welcome back to the 1<sup>st</sup> half of our Spring term. We hope you have enjoyed the holiday period.

### Themes –

#### Counting Rhymes

Activities to include: Counting with fingers, counting objects related to the rhymes, playing counting games, craft activities and making up stories for the characters in the rhymes.

**Chinese New Year** – (Starts 25<sup>th</sup> January) We will look at what occurs, the story behind the naming of the animals, carry out craft activities, count animals from the story and do some dancing to Chinese music.

#### Staying Safe

We will be discussing PANTS. It is line with the NSPCC ideas on the ‘underwear rule’. It teaches children that their body belongs to them, they have a right to say no and that they should tell an adult if they’re upset or worried. 
