Sukkot is a Jewish celebration, celebrating the harvest of the land in Israel.

Staying safe themes are followed every other week. We will use our Persona doll Gordon, to deliver these messages to the children.

Your child may bring items in for the topic to show us. Can we please ask that any other toys brought in, other than comforters, are shown to staff and friends and then taken home with you. Last year we had mislaid toys that caused some upset.

## **Nursery Expansion**

Over the last week of the summer holidays we have had extensive work carried out in our kitchen so that we can now provide hot meals for children in the late afternoon who are staying from 4.30pm onwards. Due to health and hygiene reasons, the office is now temporarily situated in the small back room, therefore we are asking parents/carers to use the front door for drop off and pick up times temporarily.

In the near future (November), we will be opening a baby unit. We have acquired a building that will allow us to join the existing part of the nursery. The office will then be permanently based in the middle of the buildings.

In the short term we would like to reassure parents/carers that this will not effect group times. Children will still split between 'Caterpillars and Butterflies', in the main nursery room. If you have any concerns, thoughts or questions please do not hesitate to talk to Mandy.

## **Illness**

Please can we remind parents that your child should not be attending nursery if you have had to give them Calpol or other fever reducing medicine. They will not be well enough to cope with a session.

## Notes from Parent/Carer in Bag

We do not normally look in children's bags. If you send information or replies in then please hand them to a member of staff or, if another adult is bringing your child in then ask them to give any notes, etc to staff.

#### **Lunch Boxes**

Please remember to clearly label lunch boxes on the outside and drink bottles with your child's name. It is very hard for cover members of staff to know which things belong to which child and our own members of staff change over during lunch times.
